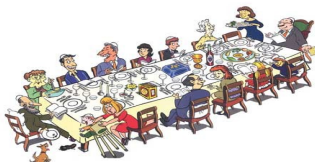

** Do not light before the time indicated. Light from pre-existing flame. Such as a gas pilot etc.

*** Do not light after noted time. Light from pre-existing flame. If you come to services, you can Light at the Shul!
